

I. Message from President

The Asia Pacific Federation for Non-Destructive Testing (APFNDT) was established at Mumbai in India in 2013 to meet demands from the providers and users of NDT in the Asia Pacific Region for promoting the application of NDT and for encouraging research and development into NDT techniques. The main activities of APFNDT have therefore covered education, qualification and certification, training, standardization etc. over the whole NDI spectrum.

APFNDT also has a responsibility for the safe use of NDT and has to extend this safety responsibility in a more general sense to the public for ensuring the integrity of products, assemblies and structures, plants etc. during their service life. This responsibility will make it the goal of NDT certified personnel to strive to improve their skills and expertise through education and training.

The member countries in APFNDT are now facing important circumstances towards the ISO 9712 revised in 2012 and there may be more demands on harmonization of NDT personnel at the international level for qualification and certification based on the requirements of ISO 9712. In this regard APFNDT members should develop strong and friendly collaboration with other regions and their vitality will be requested to do so.

In addition communication occurs through the conduct of national and international conferences, symposia, seminars, workshops etc.

APFNDT will involve in national and international activities with the aim to promote and develop NDT as a key technology to be used by the industrial sector.

Lastly, I would like to work together with the members and societies in not only the Asia Pacific region but also other regions as a president of APFNDT.

II. Final report of APCNDT 2013, Mumbai, India

The Asia Pacific Conference on Non-Destructive Testing (APCNDT) is held once in 4 years. The Japanese Society for Non-Destructive Inspection (JSNDI) had the privilege of hosting the first Conference during March, 1976. The Indian Society for Non-Destructive Testing (ISNT) was given the

responsibility of hosting the 14th Conference. Incidentally, India had the unique opportunity of hosting the 14th World Conference way back in 1996.

14th APCNDT was held at Mumbai, India between 18th and 22nd November, 2013. The Conference was inaugurated by Dr. Avinash Chander, Scientific Advisor to Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India on 18th November, 2013 which was followed by two memorial lectures.

- (1) Prof. A.K. Rao Memorial Lecture: "Probabilistic Monitoring of Fatigue Cracks in Aircraft Structures" by Prof. Jan Achenbach, Walter P. Murphy & Distinguished McCormick School Professor Emeritus
- (2) Shri V.S. Jain Memorial Lecture: "NDT in Metal Processing Industries for Critical Sectors" by Shri M. Narayana Rao, CMD, MIDHANI.

A record number of 246 papers were presented in the form of Invited and Submitted Talks. Three parallel sessions were held to accommodate large number of papers. In addition to this, in order to encourage students and upcoming Scientists, a poster session consisting of 59 papers was held simultaneously. 800 delegates representing 26 countries participated in the proceedings. 65 international companies exhibited their products in a sprawling area of 730 sq. mts. The Conference also saw the participation of leaders from American Society, Chinese Society, Korean Society, Singapore Society, Australian Society and Malaysian Society.

On 21st of November, 2013, the Asia Pacific Federation for Non Destructive Testing (APFNDT) was formed fostering a new era of co-operation between Societies in the Asia Pacific Region. At the closing ceremony, the responsibility of conducting the next Conference (15th APCNDT) was officially handed over to the Office Bearers of Singapore Society (NDTSS).

Overall, the Conference provided an excellent platform for Researchers, Students, Professionals and Manufacturers to interact and derive benefits from the deliberations.



The IIW community convened in Seoul from 13 to 18 July. The event gathered 768 experts and delegates from all over the world. At the conference, The KSNT organized special session of NDT on 17 July. 4 papers presented and keynote speaker was Dr. Seungseok Lee, the past president of KSNT.

International Workshop of KPCN

In recent years, the KSNT has established Personnel Certification Body based on ISO/IEC 17024 and certification schemes based on ISO 9712 in Korea. It's called Korean Personnel Certification in NDT (KPCN). The Korean Accreditation Board is expected to accredit the KSNT as Certification Body (CB) in a few months.

As part of the efforts to review and go forward, the KSNT organized the international workshop during IIW 2014. NDTSS President, Mr. Ir. Sajeesh Kumar Babu and Chair of ICNDT WG1, Mr. Alexander Mullin were invited to speak about the answer of some issues.

Preparation of 15APCNDT

The final preparation of awarding the conference & exhibition organizer contract is on the way, the organizing committee is formed & lead by one of the society vice president Mr. Madhavan. The Venue will be finalized by October 2014. The website would be available for registration & call for abstract will be made by October 2014 in Prague.

It is expected to have 800 participants in Singapore, the conference would be held in November 2017. The dates & first announcement would be issued shortly & NDTSS would exhibit in the 11th ECNDT Prague.

MOU with Regional Institution



The Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Land Transport Authority of Singapore (LTA), SMRT Corporation Ltd (SMRT), SBS Transit Ltd (SBS Transit), and Non-Destructive Testing Society of Singapore (NDTSS). The MOU seals a landmark partnership between SIT, LTA, SMRT, SBS Transit, and NDTSS to jointly develop a high quality and industry-relevant curriculum for SIT's new Sustainable Infrastructure Engineering (SIE) programme [Master of Engineering Technology & Bachelor of Engineering with Honours in Sustainable Infrastructure Engineering (Land)] to be offered from AY2014 onwards. The unique feature of the SIE degree programme is the opportunity for students to opt for Non-Destructive Testing (NDT) certification (ISO 9712, in collaboration with the NDTSS) to enhance their industry-readiness prior to graduation. This is a significant departure from the industry norm where Engineering students typically attain NDT certification only after they begin

employment, and are often only able to do so in-house within their companies.
