Approved Minutes of the meeting of The APFNDT General Assembly Meeting Held At Marina Bay Sands Convention Centre in Singapore

6th December: Commenced at 0925 hours

1. Welcome

7. Strategic Plan update

The meeting were advised that as the Constitution and Operating Procedures had just passed into currency, that the Strategic Plan would also now need to be updated in the coming cycle. 8.1 Income/Expenditure

The Treasurer (Mr. Smith) presented the financial position, showing both "previous & current" (via slides) & gave a verbal report on the activities undertaken by the AEC/Board.

8.2 Budget for coming year

The Treasurer (Mr. Smith) relayed that with funds in reserve slowly climbing (due to more members and donations), that expenses have now been budgeted for and therefore presented the Boards planned expenditure over the coming period (2019-2021).

9. Reports by APFNDT internal committees and task groups

9.1 Advisory Group Report

9.2 Task Group Reports

• TG 1 Membership

The Chair Mr. Smith gave a brief verbal report advising of the memberships being renewed by Mongolia and that TG were still working with Indonesia/Pakistan/Iran and Bangladesh to complete membership requirements.

• No Reports for TG's 2, 4, 5

• TG 3 Communications

The Chair Mr. S Ooka spoke of the pending changes for the website etc, plus the on-going need for inputs from Societies.

• TG 6 Standards

The Chair Dr. Ogata has tabled a funding request with the board for standards (which is being considered) & that they would be looking into being involved with ISO/TC 261 "Additive Manufacturing"

• NEW TG 7 NDT 4.0

Mr. P Wadyalkar briefly spoke on the need for involvement with the new Robotics & associated methods being more widely used, that the APFNDT needed to be involved. Therefore he was pleased that the board had agreed to allow him to form this new TG and to act as its interim chair. The TG would be looking into: Guidelines/Standards/Communications etc, in collaboration with the ICNDT group on NDT4.0

At this point (1145hrs) it was suggested that the meeting adjourn for a photo session and lunch break.

10. Asia Pacific Conference Reports

10.1 Update from 16th APCNDT Progress (Melbourne 2021)

Mr. Peter Milligan (Guest for reporting Only) gave a quick update on 2021, saying that the AINDT had concerns that the next WCCM was also now scheduled for 2021 in Beijing & that surely as an APFNDT member Society the ChSNDT would have considered the obvious clash with the APCNDT Conference, when agreeing to co-host this event!

The meeting agreed that clashes of this nature were not good for either organization.

10.2 Update from 17th APCNDT Progress (Hawaii 2025)

Mr. Smith gave a quick update on 2025 preparation, saying that the event would effectively be being held in "Late Spring" of 2025 (so March-June) in Honolulu.

Currently they had two venue otions:

- Hilton Hawaiian Village Resort (had to be March)
- Plus another option which was more flexible with dates

11. Reports by External Organizations

The General Secretary (Mr. Dick) advised that there were no external reports.

12. Opportunity for comments by National Societies

- The representative for SNTCT Prof. Chih-Hung Chiang thanked both the APFNDT and NDTSS together for the organizing of such a great event and information and that SNTCT hopes to attend more of our meetings over the coming years.
- The representative for AINDT Mr .Pranay Wadyalkar asked what difficulties smaller Societies (such as Sri Lanka and Mongolia) find in participating.
 - Dr Koshala (SNDT) said that yes they were a very small Society but with internal assistance they were managing activities at this time.
 - Dr. Bultger (MSNDT), Thanked the APFNDT for granting Mongolia Full Membership, which had allowed them to attend the Certification meetings. He also requested the help of Societies like NDTSS to "help them grow up".
- The representative for MSNT Dr. Nassir Ibrahim spoke of a planned conference in Malaysia over Dec 7-8 2020.
- The representative for NDTSS Dr. S Babu, spoke on the difficulties experienced by his Society due to the shortfall in attendees to the WCCM Conference from that booked the venue. Stating that there was a "shortfall penalty payment" being withheld by MBS. Therefore, they were having to now having to run a follow up "SINCE" Conference over July 8-9 2021 to try to recoup the funds lost. "This needed to be a warning to others, when booking venues for large numbers", esp when dealing with outside organizations.

13. ICNDT Related Matters

• The ISNT representative Dr. B Venkatraman, mentioned that India would be bidding to host the 2028 WCNDT and therefore requested support from the Federation members when it came to the



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vote at ICNDT.

• The KSNT representative Prof. JP Lee gave a very brief report on preparations for WCNDT 2020, saying that they had received 1075 papers and that the 350 trade booths had sold out!
